22 **state construction projects with budgets over \$50,000.** All bids received from contractors
23 who are not certified will be rejected. **These changes take effect January 1, 2014.** Contractor

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29 Bids must be received at State of Wisconsin Administration Building, 101 East Wilson Street, 7th
30 Floor Reception Desk, Madison, Wisconsin 53703, on or before the closing date and time
31 indicated above.

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33 In general the work consists of: **The building's original electrical distribution equipment shall**
34 **be demolished and replaced to accommodate the installation of a new interior 50kW liquid**
35 **propane generator. Mechanical and structural changes shall be made to support the new**
36 **electrical equipment installed under the scope of this project. The site houses**
37 **communications equipment for essential life safety operations in the state of Wisconsin.**
38 **Extreme caution shall be exercised to ensure the building communications systems**
39 **remain online throughout the scope of this project. Temporary facilities shall be provided**
40 **to allow for the minimal number of required outages on equipment designated "critical"**
41 **by the facility and A/E.**
