10 contractors for the above project.  
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12 **All potential bidders must become certified by DOA prior to submitting bids on state construction projects**  
13 **with budgets over \$50,000.** All bids received from contractors who are not certified will be rejected. These changes  
14 take effect January 1, 2014. Contractor certification applications and instructions for completing the form may be

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28 The bidder is responsible for the sealed bid being delivered to the indicated location or email before the time  
29 specified for the bid submission. Third party delivery is entirely at the bidder's risk.

30 Bid opening will be conducted via Microsoft Teams. Bidders may call the Microsoft Teams teleconference number:

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35 In general the work consists of: Project façade repairs include installing netting (4600 SF) over existing ceramic  
36 tile and fastening netting back to existing brick backup behind ceramic tile. Fasteners are 3/8" dia x 6" stainless  
37 anchors as noted on drawings (approximately 7 square feet o/c).  
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39 Construction bidding documents (drawings, specifications and addenda) may be obtained only as downloadable  
40 electronic files (in PDF format) from the Division of Facilities Development website. Construction bidding  
41 documents may also be available at various Builders' Exchanges. Additional project bidding information, including  
42 plan holders lists are available on the Division of Facilities Development public website:

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48 Contract offer and construction phase records will be processed electronically on the WisBuild™ DFD Information  
49 System.  
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51 **The 2017-2019 Wisconsin State Budget (2017 Wisconsin Act 59) repealed Wisconsin's prevailing wage laws.**  
52 **Effective September 23, 2017, state prevailing wage requirements on state building projects no longer apply.**  
53 **These changes take effect for projects advertised for bid after September 23, 2017. This change does not**  
54 **affect the Federal Davis Bacon Act requirements.**
