When 85% or more 29 of the construction cost of a project could be completed by a Single Trade Contractor (mechanical, 30 electrical, plumbing, or fire protection), the Department may bid and contract all work of that 31 construction project directly to a Single Trade Contractor. The State will enter into a single contract 32 with the lowest, qualified, responsible, certified single trade MEP contractor. Single trade MEP 33 contractors may bid on single trade projects up to their current division of work certification level for 34 that trade. All Work for this project will be awarded to a single trade Electrical contractor. Bidders 35 shall submit a Single Base Bid for all Work. 36 37 Sealed bids will be received at the State of Wisconsin Administration Building, 7th Floor, 101 East Wilson 38 Street, Madison, Wisconsin 53703, before the time indicated above. The bidder is responsible for the sealed 39 bid being delivered to the indicated location for receipt stamping before the time specified for the bid opening. 40 Third party delivery is entirely at the bidder's risk. 41 In general the work consists of the replacement of the existing personal duress system at the Winnebago 42 43 Mental Health Institute.
