17 **bids on state construction projects over \$50,000.** All bids received from contractors who are not certified

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23 Sealed bids will be received at the State of Wisconsin Administration Building, 7th Floor, 101 East Wilson  
24 Street, Madison, Wisconsin 53703, before the time indicated above. The bidder is responsible for the sealed  
25 bid being delivered to the indicated location for receipt stamping before the time specified for the bid opening.  
26 Third party delivery is entirely at the bidder's risk.

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28 In general the work consists of **renovation of the food service building at Mendota Mental Health**  
29 **Institute. A new kitchen will be constructed in the location of the present Conference Center space.**  
30 **This will allow meal preparation to continue while the new kitchen is constructed. All mechanical**  
31 **electrical and plumbing systems will be replaced. Abandoned built in coolers and freezers will be**  
32 **demolished to allow for better food and material storage in the lower level. The building envelope will**  
33 **be repaired to preserve the structural integrity of the building. An accessible entrance and vertical**  
34 **platform lift will be added to the southwest entrance.**

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45 **Base Bids will be received as follows: A single lump sum bid for All Work.**

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47 Bidders shall identify the division of work being bid when requesting Bidding Documents online.

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49 No deposit is required to obtain documents for bidding purposes.

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51 Bid Guarantee in the amount of 10% of the Bid must accompany each bid submitted.

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53 Contract offer and construction phase records will be processed electronically on the WisBuild™ DFD  
54 Information System.

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**The 2017-2019 Wisconsin State Budget (2017 Wisconsin Act 59) repealed Wisconsin’s prevailing wage laws. Effective September 23, 2017, state prevailing wage requirements on state building projects no longer apply. These changes take effect for projects advertised for bid after September 23, 2017. This change does not affect the Federal Davis Bacon Act requirements.**

A non-mandatory pre-bid tour will be held, and a pre-bid conference will be held on September 20, 2022, promptly at 9:00 a.m. The scheduled Prebid tour is the only time that prospective bidders will be able to access the building for review. Meet at the Mendota Mental Health Institute Food Service Building, 301 Troy Drive, Madison, Wisconsin. Visitors will be required to wear surgical grade face mask on site at all times.
