In general, the work consists of: Removing approximately 6,910 s.f. of built-up roof and EPDM membrane and rigid insulation to existing deck, installing new rigid insulation and fully adhered EPDM membrane, replacing existing metal coping with new metal coping on the boiler plant and pump house buildings.

Construction bidding documents (drawings, specifications and addenda) may be obtained only as downloadable electronic files (in PDF format) from the Division of Facilities Development website. Construction bidding documents may also be available at various Builders' Exchanges. Additional project construction bidding information, including plan holders list, is available on the DFD website.
