14 OWNER: State of Wisconsin, Department of Administration, Division of Facilities Development,
15 hereinafter termed DFD.

16
17 **All potential bidders must be certified by DOA prior to submitting bids on state construction**
18 **projects over \$50,000.** All bids received from contractors who are not certified will be rejected. Contractor
19 certification applications and instructions for completing the form may be obtained from the DOA Website

23 **Only bidders who have been certified by DOA as a qualified and responsible bidder in the**
24 **ELECTRICAL division of work may bid on this project.**

25
26 **This project is being let using a new single trade bidding and contracting process. When 85% or**
27 **more of the construction cost of a project could be completed by a Single Trade Contractor**
28 **(mechanical, electrical, plumbing, or fire protection), the Department may bid and contract all work**
29 **of that construction project directly to a Single Trade Contractor. The State will enter into a single**
30 **contract with the lowest, qualified, responsible, certified single trade MEP contractor. Single trade**
31 **MEP contractors may bid on single trade projects up to their current division of work certification**
32 **level for that trade. All Work for this project will be awarded to a single trade ELECTRICAL**
33 **contractor. Bidders shall submit a Single Base Bid for all Work.**

35 Sealed bids will be received as follows, before the time indicated above:

45 The bidder is responsible for the sealed bid being delivered to the indicated location or email before the
46 time specified for the bid submission. Third party delivery is entirely at the bidder's risk.
47 Bid opening will be conducted via Microsoft Teams. Bidders may call the Microsoft Teams teleconference
48 number: (608) 571-2209, conference ID: 484 588 360#, on the day of the bid to hear the bid results
49 announced on the day bids are due. The conference line will be open at 1:45 P.M. CDT and all bids will be

53 In general the work consists of replacing thirteen electrical panels, replacement of the fire pump service
54 disconnect, and circuit breakers require setting changes. Additionally, circuit breaker testing and

1 equipment cleaning will be performed on switchgear, transfer switches, power distribution units (PDUs),
2 and other identified service panels. New arc flash warning labels shall be attached to new and existing
3 equipment. Coordination with utility for power outages is required. The project will take place on all
4 levels of the building. Tommy G Thompson Center was constructed in 1996, has 133,016 square feet on
5 eight floors and an underground parking ramp.

7 Bidding documents (drawings, specifications, and addenda) may be obtained only as electronic files (in
8 PDF format): as a downloadable file from the Division's Projects Bidding website (see website address
9 below) and/or on compact discs or DVD by ordering from the Construction Project Bidding Opportunities
10 webpage. Bidding documents may also be seen at various Builders' Exchanges. Additional project bidding
11 information, including plan holders lists are available on the Division of Facilities Development public
12 website: <https://doa.wi.gov/Pages/AboutDOA/FacilitiesDevelopment.aspx>. After opening the web page,
13 select Current Construction Project Bidding Opportunities at the bottom of the screen. Bidder shall identify
14 the division of work they are bidding on when requesting Bidding Documents online. No deposit is
15 required to obtain documents for bidding purposes.

17 **Base Bids will be received as follows: A single lump sum bid for All Work.**

19 Bid Guarantee in the amount of 10% of the Bid must accompany each bid submitted.

20
21 Contract offer, and construction phase records will be processed electronically on the WisBuild™ DFD
22 Information System.

24 **The 2017-2019 Wisconsin State Budget (2017 Wisconsin Act 59) repealed Wisconsin's prevailing**
25 **wage laws. Effective September 23, 2017, state prevailing wage requirements on state building**
26 **projects no longer apply. These changes take effect for projects advertised for bid after September**
27 **23, 2017. This change does not affect the Federal Davis Bacon Act requirements.**

30 A non-mandatory pre-bid tour is scheduled for June 01, 2023, at 10 AM at 201 West Washington Avenue
31 in Madison, WI in the main lobby. It is encouraged that contractors attend.
