When 85% or 27 more of the construction cost of a project could be completed by a Single Trade Contractor 28 (mechanical, electrical, plumbing, or fire protection), the Department may bid and contract all work 29 of that construction project directly to a Single Trade Contractor. The State will enter into a single contract with the lowest, qualified, responsible, certified single trade MEP contractor. Single trade 30 31 MEP contractors may bid on single trade projects up to their current division of work certification 32 level for that trade. All Work for this project will be awarded to a single trade MECHANICAL 33 contractor. Effective September 23, 2017, state prevailing wage requirements on state building projects no longer apply. These changes take effect for projects advertised for bid after September 23 24 23, 2017.
