17 **state construction projects with budgets over \$50,000.** All bids received from contractors
18 who are not certified will be rejected. **These changes take effect January 1, 2014.** Contractor

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24 Bids must be received at State of Wisconsin Administration Building, 101 East Wilson Street, 7th
25 Floor Reception Desk, Madison, Wisconsin 53703, on or before the closing date and time
26 indicated above.

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28 In general the work consists of: **grading, landscaping, and stormwater management devices.**

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30 Construction bidding documents (drawings, specifications and addenda) may be obtained only
31 as downloadable electronic files (in PDF format) from the Division of Facilities Development
32 website. Construction bidding documents may also be available at various Builders' Exchanges.
33 Additional project construction bidding information, including plan holders list, is available on the
34 DFDM website. Please note that a WisBuild login and password are required to download bidding
35 documents. Interested parties may request a WisBuild login and password at the DFDM website
36 – allow 2 days to process login and password requests.

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38 **The 2017-2019 Wisconsin State Budget (2017 Wisconsin Act 59) repealed Wisconsin's**
39 **prevailing wage laws. Effective September 23, 2017, state prevailing wage requirements**
40 **on state building projects no longer apply. These changes take effect for projects**
41 **advertised for bid after September 23, 2017. This change does not affect the Federal**
42 **Davis Bacon Act requirements.**
