DFD will publicly bid the applicable mechanical, electrical, plumbing, and fire protection (MEP) divisions of work first. Within 5 27 28 days of the MEP bid opening, DFD will identify a lowest, qualified, responsible, certified bidder in each applicable MEP division of work. These successful MEP bids must be included in all general prime 29 contractor bids received. No later than 5 days after DFD identifies the successful MEP bids, DFD will 30 31 publicly open general prime contractor bids. General prime contractor bids that do not include the 32 successful MEP bids will be rejected. The state will enter into a single contract with the lowest, qualified, responsible, certified general prime contractor and this general prime contractor will enter into subcontracts 33 34 with the successful MEP bidders. building, connected by a 4,162 square foot covered plaza, and new site infrastructure. The project is

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located at W372 S9727 Hwy 67 on the Old World Wisconsin Outdoor Ethnic Museum site located in Eagle, Wisconsin. The work scope includes cast-in-place concrete, unit masonry, limestone, structural steel framing, metal fabrications, metal stairs, pipe and tube railings, rough carpentry, sheathing, shop-fabricated wood trusses, glue-laminated construction, interior and exterior finish carpentry, interior architectural woodwork, sheet waterproofing, insulation, air barriers, standing seam metal roofing, sheet metal flashing and trim, sheet metal roofing specialties, sealants, hollow metal doors and frames, flush wood doors, stile and rail wood doors, access doors and frames, aluminum storefront, hardware, glazing, decorative windows films, fixed louvers, GWB, ceramic tiling, acoustical ceiling tiles, resilient flooring and base, resinous flooring, tile carpeting, painting, high performance coatings, visual display surfaces, signage, building dedication plaque, dimensional letter signage, toilet compartments, wall and door protection, toilet accessories, fire extinguishers and cabinets, roller window shades, metal casework, plumbing, HVAC, site lighting, lighting and light controls, electrical / communications wiring, lightning protection, audio-visual, access control, video surveillance, site clearing, earthmoving, trenching, erosion control, asphalt paving, decorative metal fences, plants, seeding, sodding, water utility distribution, sanitary sewerage utilities, storm drainage utilities, and fuel distribution utilities.

 The 2017-2019 Wisconsin State Budget (2017 Wisconsin Act 59) repealed Wisconsin's prevailing wage laws. Effective September 23, 2017, state prevailing wage requirements on state building projects no longer apply. These changes take effect for projects advertised for bid after September 23, 2017. This change does not affect the Federal Davis Bacon Act requirements.
