In general the work consists of: The installation of a reinforced concrete perimeter curbing on select areas of Level 5. Curbing includes modifications to pedestrian barriers between precast stitch walls, elastomeric sealant work, urethane traffic membrane work.

Level 2 work includes the select repair of precast TT edges, TT to TT shear connection weld inspection and repairs, removal and replacement of all TT joint sealant to limits, installation of urethane hybrid traffic membrane over existing unknown traffic membrane and bare concrete. Traffic painting of directional arrows to be performed. The removal and replacement of adjacent metal pedestrian railings are required. Phasing of work is required to maintain one functioning entry traffic lane to parking structure at all times.
