All bids received from contractors who are 18 not certified will be rejected. DFD will publicly 24 bid the applicable mechanical, electrical, plumbing, and fire protection (MEP) divisions of work first. 25 Within 5 days of the MEP bid opening, DFD will identify a lowest, qualified, responsible, certified bidder 26 in each applicable MEP division of work. These successful MEP bids must be included in all general prime 27 contractor bids received. No later than 5 days after DFD identifies the successful MEP bids, DFD will 28 publicly open general prime contractor bids. General prime contractor bids that do not include the 29 successful MEP bids will be rejected. The state will enter into a single contract with the lowest, qualified, 30 responsible, certified general prime contractor and this general prime contractor will enter into subcontracts 31 with the successful MEP bidders. If a project does not include any mechanical, electrical, plumbing, or 32 fire protection divisions of work, DFD will bid one bid package for all work to general prime 33 contractors. 34 35 Sealed bids will be received at the State of Wisconsin Administration Building, 7th Floor, 101 East Wilson 36 Street, Madison, Wisconsin 53703, before the time indicated above. The bidder is responsible for the sealed 37 bid being delivered to the indicated location for receipt stamping before the time specified for the bid 38 opening. Third party delivery is entirely at the bidder's risk. 39 In general, the work consists of performing exterior envelope repairs to the following buildings at 41 the University of Wisconsin – Milwaukee Campus: 42 43 GARLAND HALL: Project work includes sealant replacement at sheet metal flashing, limestone,

44 sandstone, brick masonry joints and window perimeter joints. Masonry patch and crack repairs at 45 concrete, terra cotta, limestone and sandstone. It also includes repointing of deteriorated mortar 46 joints, rebuilding exterior wythe of brick masonry, installation of lead T-caps at coping units, 47

installation of new handrails at the first-floor entrance, installation of new steel stair system,

general cleaning of masonry, and painting of railing sections.

PEARSE HALL: Project work includes sealant replacement at sheet metal flashing, limestone, sandstone, brick masonry joints and window perimeter joints. Sealant replacement at existing vertical and step crack repairs. Masonry patch and crack repairs at concrete, terra cotta, limestone and sandstone. It also includes repointing of deteriorated mortar joints, rebuilding exterior wythe of brick masonry, installation of lead T-caps at coping units, expansion joint replacement at Garland-Pearse connecter building.
VOGEL HALL: Project work includes sealant replacement at Vogel-Pearse connecting expansion joint, sheet metal flashing, limestone, sandstone, brick masonry joints and window perimeter joints.
It also includes repointing of deteriorated mortar joints, area well grating replacement, east entry concrete slab replacement and rehabilitation of wood fascia.

Bidding documents (drawings, specifications, and addenda) may be obtained only as electronic files (in PDF format): as a downloadable file from the Division's Projects Bidding website (see website address below) and/or on compact discs or DVD by ordering from the Construction Project Bidding Opportunities webpage. ## Base Bid will be received for: A single lump sum bid for All Work.

No deposit is required to obtain documents for bidding purposes.

Bid Guarantee in the amount of 10% of the Bid must accompany each bid submitted.

Contract offer and construction phase records will be processed electronically on the WisBuild $^{TM}$  DFD Information System.

The 2017-2019 Wisconsin State Budget (2017 Wisconsin Act 59) repealed Wisconsin's prevailing wage laws. Effective September 23, 2017, state prevailing wage requirements on state building projects no longer apply. These changes take effect for projects advertised for bid after September 23, 2017. This change does not affect the Federal Davis Bacon Act requirements.

A non-mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held on **October 3, 2022 promptly at 1:00 pm.** The pre-bid conference will be held onsite at the scheduled date and time. Bidders and project team should meet at the Pearse Hall entrance on the north side of the building at 1:00 pm for meeting and tour. Advance registration for participation in meeting is required and bidders should contact ZS LLC a minimum of 36 hours in advance to the pre-bid conference to receive information:
