15 **with budgets over \$50,000.** All bids received from contractors who are not certified will be rejected. These changes

31 specified for the bid submission. Third party delivery is entirely at the bidder's risk.

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37 In general the work consists of: pulverizing and repaving the access roads and parking areas that surround the
