40 July 1, 2023 – June 30, 2025.

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4 **The 2017-2019 Wisconsin State Budget (2017 Wisconsin Act 59) repealed Wisconsin's prevailing**  
5 **wage laws. Effective September 23, 2017, state prevailing wage requirements on state building**  
6 **projects no longer apply. These changes take effect for projects advertised for bid after September**  
7 **23, 2017. This change does not affect the Federal Davis Bacon Act requirements.**
