22 who are not certified will be rejected. **These changes take effect January 1, 2014.** Contractor

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32 In general the work consists of: Remove and replace existing exterior pad mounted generator
33 with a new 800kw generator with reach in enclosure.

39 website. Construction bidding documents may also be available at various Builders' Exchanges.

42 documents. Interested parties may request a WisBuild login and password at the DFD website –
43 allow 2 days to process login and password requests.

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45 **The 2017-2019 Wisconsin State Budget (2017 Wisconsin Act 59) repealed Wisconsin's**
46 **prevailing wage laws. Effective September 23, 2017, state prevailing wage requirements**
47 **on state building projects no longer apply. These changes take effect for projects**
48 **advertised for bid after September 23, 2017. This change does not affect the Federal**
49 **Davis Bacon Act requirements.**
