25	submitted prior to bid submission. DFD must approve all subcontractors.

27	This project is being let using the single prime bidding and contracting process. DFD will publicly bid the
28	applicable mechanical, electrical, plumbing, and fire protection (MEP) divisions of work <u>first.</u> Within 5
29	days of the MEP bid opening, DFD will identify a lowest, qualified, responsible, certified bidder in each
30	applicable MEP division of work. These successful MEP bids must be included in all general prime
31	contractor bids received. No later than 5 days after DFD identifies the successful MEP bids, DFD will
32 33	publicly open general prime contractor bids. General prime contractor bids that do not include the successful MEP bids will be rejected. The state will enter into a single contract with the lowest, qualified,
34	responsible, certified general prime contractor and this general prime contractor will enter into subcontracts
35	with the successful MEP bidders. If a project does not include any mechanical, electrical, plumbing, or
36	fire protection divisions of work, DFD will bid one bid package for all work to general prime
37	contractors.

In general the work consists of removal of the existing roofing systems (~180 squares). The primary roof areas are sprayed foam roofing with a granulated silicone toping. Below these is the original roof material placed directly on the deck. Removal of the canopy roofs is included, one is a ten year old EPDM while the other in a gravel surfaced modified bitumen. All roof areas are to be removed down to the structural deck and replaced with a fully adhered, ¼":12" sloped insulation, 60-mil minimum EPDM.

Contract offer and construction phase records will be processed electronically on the WisBuild $^{\text{TM}}$ DFD Information System.

The 2017-2019 Wisconsin State Budget (2017 Wisconsin Act 59) repealed Wisconsin's prevailing wage laws. Effective September 23, 2017, state prevailing wage requirements on state building projects no longer apply. These changes take effect for projects advertised for bid after September 23, 2017. This change does not affect the Federal Davis Bacon Act requirements.
