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1 In general the work consists of: 2 3 This project replaces aged electrical distribution systems including medium voltage equipment, main 4 distribution panels, branch circuit panels, and feeders for Hathorn Hall. Project also will provide 5 emergency and optional standby power for life safety systems and critical equipment necessary to prevent 6 building freeze-up or flooding in an outage. Emergency and optional standby automatic transfer switches 7 and distribution equipment will be provided. Existing circuits will be extended and connected to new 8 distribution equipment. Effective September 23, 2017, state prevailing wage requirements on state building 29 projects no longer apply. These changes take effect for projects advertised for bid after September 30 23, 2017.
