17 advertising for bids from certified contractors for the above project.
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19 **NOTICE: All potential bidders must become certified by DOA prior to submitting bids on**
20 **state construction projects with budgets over \$50,000.** All bids received from contractors
21 who are not certified will be rejected. **These changes take effect January 1, 2014.** Contractor

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27 Bids must be received at State of Wisconsin Administration Building, 101 East Wilson Street, 7th
28 Floor Reception Desk, Madison, Wisconsin 53703, on or before the closing date and time
29 indicated above.
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31 In general the work consists of: Partial removal of existing steam box conduit and approximately
32 200 lineal feet of direct buried steam and condensate pipe from Steam Pit 11 to the Murphy
33 Library. Work includes tree removal, utility protection, sidewalk removal and replacement,
34 electrical removal and replacement and surface restoration. The new steam and condensate
35 pipes will be reconnected to existing pipes within Steam Pit 11 and within the mechanical room
36 of Murphy Library, and includes replacement of steam pit shut-off valves.
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39 Construction bidding documents (drawings, specifications and addenda) may be obtained only
40 as downloadable electronic files (in PDF format) from the Division of Facilities Development
41 website. Construction bidding documents may also be available at various Builders' Exchanges.
42 Additional project construction bidding information, including plan holders list, is available on the
43 DFD website. Please note that a WisBuild login and password are required to download bidding
44 documents. Interested parties may request a WisBuild login and password at the DFD website –
45 allow 2 days to process login and password requests.
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47 **The 2017-2019 Wisconsin State Budget (2017 Wisconsin Act 59) repealed Wisconsin's**
48 **prevailing wage laws. Effective September 23, 2017, state prevailing wage requirements**
49 **on state building projects no longer apply. These changes take effect for projects**
50 **advertised for bid after September 23, 2017. This change does not affect the Federal**
51 **Davis Bacon Act requirements.**
