12 **All potential bidders must become certified by DOA prior to submitting bids on state construction projects**  
13 **with budgets over \$50,000.** All bids received from contractors who are not certified will be rejected. These changes

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35 In general, the work consists of: removing existing concrete and asphalt, removing curb, removing planting beds,  
36 removing lighted bollards, site grading, installing asphalt, sidewalk, curb and gutter, color and stamped concrete  
37 pavement, retaining/seat wall, site lighting, pavement marking, signing, storm sewer, landscaping, site restoration  
38 and miscellaneous items of work.

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52 **The 2017-2019 Wisconsin State Budget (2017 Wisconsin Act 59) repealed Wisconsin's prevailing wage laws.**

13 for background checks. Weapons are not permitted on the grounds.
