Bidders may also join the Microsoft Teams meeting via Microsoft Teams: 39 40 Click here to join 41 42 In general the work consists of renovating the existing Building 6 on the Central Wisconsin Center (CWC) 43 campus. The existing masonry construction one-story building with a lower level contains 46,377 gross square feet and was constructed in 1963. The building will be used for either long- or short-term care for 44 45 CWC residents or for civil geriatric psychiatric patients currently cared for at Mendota Mental Health 46 Institute (MMHI). This project will correct Life Safety Code deficiencies that were identified during a 47 2008 regulatory inspection and includes the installation of a fire sprinkler protection system. Mechanical, 48 plumbing, electrical, low voltage and security systems will be replaced to bring them up to current 49 requirements. The building envelope will be updated including insulating all exterior walls and installing 50 psychiatric windows. The project includes demolition and remodel of the first floor and selective 51 remodeling in the basement. The building is planned as an inpatient behavioral health hospital and will 52 provide two (15) bed patient units each with a nurse station, activity spaces, dining room and support spaces. The first floor will be I-2 occupancy. The lower level will be Business occupancy housing staff 53

and building support spaces. The main entrance to the building will be relocated to an accessible route on

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the south side facing the access drive. Site work includes replacement of existing ramps to meet ADA and various sidewalk changes to provide more accessible routes. Exterior and adjacent site lighting will be upgraded. Outdoor enclosed courtyards will also be developed for patient use.

## Base Bids will be received as follows: A single lump sum bid for All Work.

Bid Guarantee in the amount of 10% of the Bid must accompany each bid submitted.

Contract offer and construction phase records will be processed electronically on the WisBuild $^{TM}$  DFD Information System.

The 2017-2019 Wisconsin State Budget (2017 Wisconsin Act 59) repealed Wisconsin's prevailing wage laws. Effective September 23, 2017, state prevailing wage requirements on state building projects no longer apply. These changes take effect for projects advertised for bid after September 23, 2017. This change does not affect the Federal Davis Bacon Act requirements.

A single prebid tour date has been set up for November 14, 2022 – 10:00 AM at Central Wisconsin Center. Attendance is non-mandatory. Contractors interested in attending the prebid tour shall send their full name, date of birth, and state driver's license number, via email to Seth Markgraf, email: <a href="markgraf@dhs.wisconsin.gov">seth.markgraf@dhs.wisconsin.gov</a> by Friday, November 10, 2022; 2:00 PM. Indicate the project number and bid tour time when sending the email. Limit of 2 individuals from any separate company for the prebid tour. Contractors attending the prebid tour shall meet at Building 6 to enter at the East end of the building off of South Rd. Contractors will be required to sign in and get temperature checked. Masks must be worn at all times when indoors.
