26	contractor bids received. No later than 5 days after DFD identifies the successful MEP bids, DFD will
27	publicly open general prime contractor bids. General prime contractor bids that do not include the
28	successful MEP bids will be rejected. The state will enter into a single contract with the lowest, qualified
29	responsible, certified general prime contractor and this general prime contractor will enter into subcontracts
30	with the successful MEP bidders. If a project does not include any mechanical, electrical, plumbing, or
31	fire protection divisions of work, DFD will bid <u>one</u> bid package for <u>all work</u> to general prime

In general, the work consists of replacement of 1960's era inefficient operable windows, fixed glazing, fixed opaque panels and frames. The existing frames and units are aluminum and set in masonry openings.

The project will replace these systems with modern efficient windows, frames, glazing and insulated

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panels. The existing systems to be replaced are original to the building which was constructed in 1962.

Multiple component failures frequently occur. Windows and worn out seals are extremely inefficient and drafty, glass is single pane standard glazing and needs to be brought up to current codes for safety and efficiency.

This change does not affect the Federal Davis Bacon Act requirements.
