When 85% or more 27 of the construction cost of a project could be completed by a Single Trade Contractor (mechanical, 28 electrical, plumbing, or fire protection), the Department may bid and contract all work of that 29 construction project directly to a Single Trade Contractor. The State will enter into a single contract with the lowest, qualified, responsible, certified single trade MEP contractor. Single trade MEP 30 31 contractors may bid on single trade projects up to their current division of work certification level for 32 that trade. All Work for this project will be awarded to a single trade Electrical contractor. Bidders 33 shall submit a Single Base Bid for all Work. 34 35 Sealed bids will be received at the State of Wisconsin Administration Building, 7th Floor, 101 East Wilson 36 Street, Madison, Wisconsin 53703, before the time indicated above. The bidder is responsible for the sealed 37 bid being delivered to the indicated location for receipt stamping before the time specified for the bid opening. 38 Third party delivery is entirely at the bidder's risk. 39 40 In general the work consists of upgrading the communications structured cabling and related infrastructure 41 at select buildings located at the Sand Ridge Secure Treatment Center. Existing communications equipment rooms will be improved at various buildings to accommodate the new cable system and future network 42 43 electronics. Effective September 23, 2017, state prevailing wage requirements on state building 11 projects no longer apply. These changes take effect for projects advertised for bid after September 12 13 23, 2017. This change does not affect the Federal Davis Bacon Act requirements. 14 15 A pre-bid Tour and Conference will be conducted at the site on 12/2/19 at 9:00AM. Participants should 16 meet at the main lobby of the Main Gatehouse Building (Building G). They will then be escorted throughout the project areas by facility staff. Bidders are highly encouraged to attend. No separate tours will 17 18 be conducted.
