14 **All potential bidders must be certified by DOA prior to submitting bids on state construction**
15 **projects over \$50,000.** All bids received from contractors who are not certified will be rejected. Contractor
16 certification applications and instructions for completing the form may be obtained from the DOA Website

19 This project is being let using the single prime bidding and contracting process. DFD will publicly bid the
20 applicable mechanical, electrical, plumbing, and fire protection (MEP) divisions of work **first**. Within 5
21 days of the MEP bid opening, DFD will identify a lowest, qualified, responsible, certified bidder in each
22 applicable MEP division of work. These successful MEP bids must be included in all general prime
23 contractor bids received. No later than 5 days after DFD identifies the successful MEP bids, DFD will
24 publicly open general prime contractor bids. **General prime contractor bids that do not include the**
25 **successful MEP bids will be rejected.** The state will enter into a single contract with the lowest, qualified,
26 responsible, certified general prime contractor and this general prime contractor will enter into subcontracts
27 with the successful MEP bidders.

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29 Sealed bids will be received as follows, before the time indicated above:

39 The bidder is responsible for the sealed bid being delivered to the indicated location or email before the
40 time specified for the bid submission. Third party delivery is entirely at the bidder's risk.
41 Bid opening will be conducted via Microsoft Teams. Bidders may call the Microsoft Teams teleconference
42 number: (608) 571-2209, conference ID: 484 588 360#, on the day of the bid to hear the bid results
43 announced on the day bids are due. The conference line will be open at 1:45 P.M. CDT and all bids will be

47 In general, the work consists of : Install fire suppression systems through the entire building. Systems will
48 include a wet sprinkler system and a pre-action sprinkler system. A nitrogen generator will supply
49 supervisory gas to the pre-action system. A new water service will be installed to feed the new fire
50 suppression systems. Existing plumbing will be connected to the new water service. A new fire alarm

1 suppression systems. Existing plumbing will be connected to the new water service. A new fire alarm
2 system will be installed through the entire building. System will include smoke detection system, a heat
3 detector system in warehouse, audio/visual devices, and alarm panels. The existing apartment, located
4 above the mezzanine, will be removed to allow for more storage and workspace. Finishes will be
5 completed to match the existing finishes located in the space. New lights will be required in this area.

25 **Base Bids will be received as a single lump sum bid for: 2) Fire Protection (Fire Suppression); 3)**
26 **Plumbing; and 5) Electrical.**

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28 Bid Guarantee in the amount of 10% of the Bid must accompany each bid submitted.

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30 **NOTICE: The 2017-2019 Wisconsin State Budget (2017 Wisconsin Act 59) repealed Wisconsin's**
31 **prevailing wage laws. Effective September 23, 2017, state prevailing wage requirements on state**
32 **building projects no longer apply. These changes take effect for projects advertised for bid after**
33 **September 23, 2017. This change does not affect the Federal Davis Bacon Act requirements.**
